Emergency Plan for the Maxi72 Corfu Challenge

Kindly find below information relating to the Maxi72 Corfu Challenge emergency plan.

Emergency plans of the marina refer to events that happen inside the marina premises.

Events that occur outside the marina are the responsibility of the Hellenic Coast Guard.

1. Marina Premises

- We have organized a team of the Corfu Rescue Team (CRT) which will be manned with qualified personnel. The CRT R.I.B will be stationed daily at the race area equipped with all the appropriate equipment.
- There is a basic first aid station in the marina office which for the days of the race will be manned with appropriate personnel. In any case the Emergency Room of the Corfu General Hospital is 500 meters away across the highway.

2. Race Area

→ **Rescue Process**

- Boats need to get in touch with Race committee
- Race committee reaches out to rescuers
- Rescuers will contact the boat in question

→ **Crane Process**

In case there is a need for a crane

- Sailing Boats need to first get in touch with the Gouvia Marina Office via channel 69 in order to receive further instructions on how to proceed with launching hauling out.
- The person responsible for the Gouvia Marina is the General Manager of the Marina Mr. Dimitrios Koutsodontis
